October has come and it's time to begin to think about our Halloween Parade and Social. Information for the event is below.

Information about the Parade

- *Costumes must be sent to school in a bag or box marked w/ student name
- *Costumes should fit over clothing (students may not wear them to and from school on the bus)
- *Costumes must be school appropriate No costumes with guns, swords, other weapons, or other inappropriate attire. Your child is not permitted to have those items as a part of his/her costume in school.
- *Students must wear shoes.
- *Avoid face make-up for the parade as there will not be time to administer it during the day.

The parade will begin promptly at 2:15 PM on the walking track in the back of the building. - 5th grade will start, followed by Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade. Students will walk one time around the walking track and then re-enter the building to return to their classrooms for the classroom social. For the safety and security of our school, spectators of the parade are not permitted to enter the building. If you wish to sign your child out early, a note must be sent into school on the day of the parade/social. You can then pick up your child at the main office.

Information about the Social

Classroom socials will follow the parade. The social is only for students, staff, and scheduled volunteers. Classroom teachers will schedule no more than 2 parent/guardian volunteers to assist with the social and parade preparation. In order to volunteer, you must have all of your clearances on file at the district administration office in the human resources department. All volunteers will need to sign-in at the main office and follow protocol for volunteers. Teachers will share with students and parents/guardians what is needed for the social.
